The American Dairy Goat Association sanctions this show and their rules shall govern.

Notice: Any person interfering with the ADGA judge or show committee and/or disrupting the show will be dismissed from the show ring and/or grounds and can be denied show privileges in the future. Show order is subject to change.

COVID-19 regulations are in effect per local area.

Registration and Recordation Certificates:

- Only American Dairy Goat Association, American Goat Society and Canadian Goat Society registered, recorded or applied for animals, that are recognized by ADGA as dairy animals, may be shown in official American Dairy Goat Association shows.
- As per ADGA Postal Ballot 2122-3: Acceptance of an ADGA stamped duplicate application for registration dated on/ after February 18, 2021 will be permitted for any age animal in lieu of a certificate of registration/recordation until September 30, 2022, if warranted by continuing extended time to owners' receipt of permanent ADGA registration certificates beyond the usual 30-day period of acceptance of this temporary registration document.
- A registration or recordation certificate or a stamped duplicate application showing the date received by the ADGA office is required for all animals under six months of age. Show officials shall not accept copies of the previously mentioned, any other document in lieu of them, or information obtained from the ADGA office via telephone, etc.
- The document for that animal to be shown must be handed to the show official who shall read it, compare its information to that on its entry form, and verify the information on both. All names included on one identification number constitute only one membership; therefore, only one exhibitor. Only the ID number on the registration/recordation certificate or on the stamped duplication application is proof of ownership.
- Persons showing animals whose registration or recordation certificates have signed transfers that have not been processed by the ADGA office must show those animals in the owner's name shown on ADGA records at that time.
- Animals with natural horns shall not be shown.



Health Requirements:

- Wyoming State Fair rules require all goats to be accompanied by a valid health certificate (CVI), if required, contact the Wyoming State Fair @ 307-358-2398. A Scrapie Premise ID number may be required to obtain the CVI, please note that tattoos accompanying a matching registration paper are acceptable Scrapie ID in Wyoming. A press release attesting to this is available on the Wyoming Livestock Board website. Health certificates will be verified at time of check-in. Diseased or injured animals will be removed from the grounds upon recommendation of the show committee.
- Animals deemed unworthy of competition by the show committee may be barred from the completion and removed from the grounds. In such cases, pen and entry fees submitted by the owner will be forfeited.

Milk out at your own discretion. Over-udderred does WILL be discriminated against.

Grooming:

- Clip goats to show standards
- All goats must be dehorned or naturally polled.

Youth Showmanship:

- Showmanship classes will begin promptly at scheduled times.

Showmanship Classes (age as of Jan 1)

- PeeWee (under 8 years)
- Junior (8-10 years)
- Intermediate (11-13 years)
- Senior (14-19 years)

Champion Challenge:

- Permanent Champions may be shown in the regular or the challenge class, whichever the owner chooses. The Grand Champion of the same show must be shown in these classes and the winners of them shall be called "Best of Breed." Permanent Champions shown in these classes are not to be barred from udder classes.
- Proof of Championship shall be either: (1) The prefix CH, GCH, or SGCH as affixed by ADGA on the animal's registration or recordation certificate; or (2) Presentation of the Permanent Champion Certificate Notification Letter issued by ADGA in conjunction with the original registration or recordation certificate. The letter is valid for use until December 31 of the year of issuance.
- The winner of the Champion Challenge class must compete in in the "Best in Show" class. An animal winning Grand Champion without Champion Challenge or Best of Breed, where Champion Challenge is contested, will forfeit the championship leg earned in the show if they fail to compete in the Best of Show class.

Sponsorship:

- Herds, individuals, clubs, or businesses may sponsor classes for \$25.00 per class. The sponsor may hang a banner in the ring and will be announced during the class. Please specify which class you would like to sponsor on the entry form.



Dogs:

- Dogs are not allowed in the penning area or barns.
- All service dogs **MUST** follow ADA guidelines. Emotional support animals, comfort animals, and therapy dogs are **NOT** service animals under Title II and Title III of the ADA.
- **Service animals are defined as dogs that are individually trained to do work or perform tasks for people with disabilities.**
- Refer to ADA.gov ([ADA 2010 Revised Requirements: Service Animals](https://www.ada.gov)) for further information.

Pens:

- Pen size is approximately 6'x4'x4'. All animals **MUST** be penned on the fairgrounds. Pens will be assigned.

Feed and Bedding:

- Owners provide their own feed and bedding. Check with local businesses for availability.

Lodging:

- Camping is allowed in the campgrounds only. Contact the State Fair Campgrounds @ 307-358-2398 for rates.
- Hotels and restaurants are within a reasonable distance.

Arrival Time:

- Pens will be available on Friday starting at 1:00 PM. Check-in will be at 9:00 AM - 1:00 PM on Saturday or by arrangements if arriving after 1:00 PM on Saturday.
- All animals must be in place and checked in prior to the start of the show.

Directions:

- From I-25 take exit 140 East onto Business 26/West Yellowstone Highway.
- Go over the river and turn south onto Brownfield Road, enter Gate 2, Wyoming State Fairgrounds.
- Follow Cowboy Drive around fairgrounds, penning in the sheep and goat barns just prior to Gate 5.
- Trailer parking in the Pepsi Lot.

Classes:

- The base date for classes is August 13, 2022
- **Junior Doe Classes**
 - Any doe under 24 months of age that has never freshened or been milked.
- **Combined Senior/Junior Classes**
 - Any doe that has ever freshened or that is being milked regularly shall compete in the Senior doe age classes. This includes dry and precocious milkers.
 - To maximize the opportunity to win a Championship leg, the Fuzzy show will be a combined Sr/Jr doe show.
 - Each breed can have 2 junior does shown to count towards a full unrestricted leg.
 - 10 does are required to make sanction, 8 does **must** be in milk. If more than 2 juniors are required to reach sanction, the leg becomes a restricted leg.
- **Group Classes - Specialty Only**
 - Available for Nigerian Dwarf Specialty ONLY. All animals in group classes must have been shown in their age class or Champion Challenge. Group classes do NOT have an entry fee. Sign them up!
